1.9 Client Compatibility

- Same WC format as 1.8
- 1.8 and 1.9 clients can be used together

Client Improvements

- svn auth
- svn copy --pin-externals
- merge conflict options
- prospective blame
- svn cleanup options
- svn info --show-item

SVN auth

- `svn auth <pattern>`
- `svn auth --remove <pattern>`

Pinning Externals

- `svn copy --pin-externals`

Merge and Conflicts

- commit out-of-date check relaxed
- external merge tool available from interactive conflict resolver
- 3-way conflict markers

Prospective Blame

- `svn blame -r HEAD:3 README.txt`
 - finds the *next* change to each line

SVN cleanup

- `svn cleanup --remove-unversioned`
- `svn cleanup --remove-ignored`
- `svn cleanup --include-externals`

SVN info – show-item

- ## Display the youngest revision of a repository:
 - % svn info --show-item=revision ^/
 - 1693514

- ## Find the root directory of a working copy:
 - % svn info --show-item=wc-root
 - /home/jrandom/src/svn/trunk

SVN admin info

- `$ svnadmin info repo/`

...

- Repository Format: 5

- Compatible With Version: 1.9.0

- Filesystem Format: 7

- FSFS Shards Packed: 0/0

- Configuration File: `repo/db/fsfs.conf`

...

Locking Improvements

- File locks for exclusive commit
- Tokens in working copy, locks in repository
- Designed for efficient checking at commit
- Lock users pay the cost
- Scaling issues adding and removing locks

HTTP Locking Problem

- WebDAV LOCK and UNLOCK requests
- Separate request per file
- HTTP pipelining
- Reduces effect of network delay
- Pipelining already used for GET requests
- Client only

FSFS Locking Problem

- Write operation for each file
- Total locks in repository matters
- Commits automatically unlock
- Unlock can dominate commit

FSFS Multiple Locks

- Multiple files per write operation
- Solves the commit problem
- Works for lock/unlock over svn://
- Server only, same on-disk format

Locking Hooks

- No change for pre-lock and pre-unlock hooks
- Multiple paths to post-lock and post-unlock
- Paths on standard input

FSFS Format 7

- New format on disk
- Logical addressing
- Complete checksum coverage
- Commit during pack

FSFS Logical Addressing

- Revision files refer to earlier files
- Reorder pack files for data locality
- Complete checksum coverage
- Dump/load required

FSX Experimental Backend

- Experimental repository backend
- Not for production
- Dump/load for upgrade

1.9 Server Compatibility

- No need to upgrade clients
- No need to upgrade repositories
- Dump/load/pack for full FSFS format 7
